Our Medical Outreach

Last year, through the generous donations from our magnanimous donors, we had yet another encompassing medical outreach program, between the month of July - September (2018) at the Federal Medical Centre, Abeokuta, Nigeria. The medical outreach, themed 'THE GIFT OF SIGHT 3.0', focused on free eye screening exercise and cataract surgery. 665 individuals were screened; 468 individuals were gifted either free eye glasses or eye drops and 100 individuals benefitted from the free cataract surgery.














Our Save-a-Soul Project






